

**EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION**  
**2014-EAB-0019**

*Application for Review Dismissed*

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On October 7, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant voluntarily left work without good cause (decision # 124615). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On December 3, 2013, ALJ Vincent conducted a hearing, and on December 13, 2013 issued Hearing Decision 13-UI-06470, affirming the Department's decision. On January 2, 2013, Hearing Decision 13-UI-06470 became final without an application for review having been filed. On January 3, 2014, claimant filed by facsimile an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

**CONCLUSIONS AND REASONS:** Claimant did not establish good cause to file an untimely application for review, and claimant's application for review should be dismissed.

ORS 657.270(4) required claimant's application for review to be filed no later than January 2, 2013; it was filed on January 3, 2013 as shown by the receipt date stamped on the document. OAR 471-041-0065 (1)(c) (October 29, 2006) (the filing date of applications for review filed by facsimile is the receipt date stamped or written on the facsimile transmission by the public employee who received the document). OAR 471-041-0070(3) requires that individuals filing late applications for review include with the late application "a written statement describing the circumstances that prevented a timely filing." Claimant did not provide any explanation as to why he filed his application one day after the filing deadline expired.

Because the application for review was filed after the 20-day deadline provided by ORS 657.270(4), and good cause to extend the time allowed has not been shown, the application for review must be dismissed.

**DECISION:** The application for review filed January 3, 2014 is dismissed. Hearing Decision 13-UI-06470 remains undisturbed.
