Affirmed Overpayment

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On February 1, 2013, October 25, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of decision #121934 concluding that claimant was not available for work for the period from October 28, 2012, through January 26, 2013. On February 21, 2013, decision #121934 became final without a request for hearing having been filed. On October 25, 2013, the Department served notice of administrative decision #93855, assessing a \$4,004 overpayment based on decision #121934. On October 29, 2013, claimant filed a telephone request for hearing. On November 22, 2013, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) issued two notices for two hearings scheduled for December 12, 2013, one at 8:15 a.m. and another at 9:30 a.m. On December 12, 2013, ALJ Vincent conducted a hearing at which claimant appeared and testified, and on December 31, 2013, issued Hearing Decision 13-UI-07422, affirming decision # 93855. On December 30, 2013, ALJ Vincent issued Hearing Decision 13-UI-07286, dismissing claimant's request for a hearing with respect to decision #121934 for failure to appear at the 8:15 a.m. hearing. Claimant filed a timely motion to reopen the hearing on decision #12194, and further proceedings are pending with the OAH. On January 2, 2014, claimant filed an application for review of Hearing Decision 13-UI-07422 with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 13-UI-07422 is affirmed.
