PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On October 18, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that claimant voluntarily left work without good cause (decision #85129). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On November 20, 2013, the Office of Administrative Hearings issued notice of a hearing scheduled for December 9, 2013, at 2:30 p.m. On December 12, 2013, ALJ R. Davis issued Hearing Decision13-UI-06297, dismissing claimant's hearing request for failure to appear. On December 16, 2013, claimant filed a request to reopen the hearing. On January 3, 2014, ALJ S. Lee reviewed claimant's request to reopen and issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-07687, denying claimant's request. On January 8, 2013, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Claimant failed to certify that she provided a copy of her argument to the other parties as required by OAR 471-041-0080(2)(a) (October 29, 2006). Therefore, we did not consider the argument when reaching this decision.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-07687 is affirmed.
