

**EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION**

**2014-EAB-0066**

*Adopted  
Late Request for Hearing Dismissed*

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On September 6, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant voluntarily left work without good cause (decision # 140717). On September 26, 2013, decision # 140717 became final without a request for hearing having been filed. On November 13, 2013, claimant filed an untimely request for hearing. On December 10, 2013, ALJ Kangas issued Hearing Decision 13-UI-06030, dismissing claimant's request for hearing as untimely, subject to claimant's "right to renew" the request by submitting a response to the "Appellant Questionnaire" attached to the hearing decision within 14 days of the date the decision was mailed.<sup>1</sup> On December 17, 2013, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) received claimant's response. On January 6, 2014, ALJ Kangas reviewed claimant's response and issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-07802, dismissing claimant's request for hearing. On January 13, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decision 14-UI-07802 is affirmed.
