PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On September 6, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant voluntarily left work without good cause (decision # 140717). On September 26, 2013, decision # 140717 became final without a request for hearing having been filed. On November 13, 2013, claimant filed an untimely request for hearing. On December 10, 2013, ALJ Kangas issued Hearing Decision 13-UI-06030, dismissing claimant's request for hearing as untimely, subject to claimant's "right to renew" the request by submitting a response to the "Appellant Questionnaire" attached to the hearing decision within 14 days of the date the decision was mailed. On December 17, 2013, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) received claimant's response. On January 6, 2014, ALJ Kangas reviewed claimant's response and issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-07802, dismissing claimant's request for hearing. On January 13, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-07802 is affirmed.
