

**EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION**  
**2014-EAB-0089**

*Reversed & Remanded*

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On October 30, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that claimant voluntarily left work without good cause (decision #81419). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On January 10, 2014, ALJ Seideman conducted a hearing and issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-08361, affirming the administrative decision. On January 15, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

ORS 657.275 provides that EAB shall review the record of the case and promptly affirm, modify, or set aside the decision of the ALJ if the Director of the Department or any interested party files a timely application for review. On January 16, 2014, EAB notified OAH that an application for review had been filed. Twenty days after claimant filed her application for review, the record is not yet complete,<sup>1</sup> and it appears that further proceedings are or may be necessary before the record can be provided. We therefore reverse Hearing Decision 14-UI-08361 as unsupported by a complete record, and remand for such other and further proceedings as may be necessary.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decision 14-UI-08361 is set aside, and this matter remanded for further proceedings consistent with this order.
