## EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2014-EAB-0107

Affirmed Disqualification Ineligible

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On October 15, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served two notices of two administrative decisions; one concluding claimant voluntarily left work without good cause (decision # 130958), and one concluding claimant was not able to work from September 22, 2013 to September 28, 2013 (decision # 134115). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On December 4, 2013, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) issued two notices of two hearings scheduled for December 18, 2013, one at 9:30 a.m., and one at 10:45 a.m. On December 18, 2013, ALJ Micheletti conducted a hearing, and on December 27, 2013, issued Hearing Decisions 13-UI-07241 and 13-UI-07243, affirming the Department's decisions. On January 16, 2014, claimant filed applications for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Pursuant to OAR 471-041-0095 (October 29, 2006), EAB consolidated its review of Hearing Decisions 13-UI-07241 and 13-UI-07243. For case-tracking purposes, this decision is being issued in duplicate (EAB Decisions 2014-EAB-0107 and 2014-EAB-0108).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decisions under review are **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decisions 13-UI-07241 and 13-UI-07243 are affirmed.
