

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION

2014-EAB-0139

Affirmed
Late Request for Hearing Dismissed

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On August 5, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding the employer discharged claimant for misconduct (decision #153705). On August 27, 2013, decision #153705 became final without a request for hearing having been filed. On September 3, 2013, claimant filed a late request for hearing. On December 16, 2013, ALJ Shoemake conducted a hearing, and on January 2, 2014 issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-07506, dismissing claimant's request for hearing. On January 22, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-07506 is affirmed.
