Affirmed Request to Reopen Denied

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On September 23, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that claimant was discharged for misconduct (decision #85901). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On November 7, 2013, the Office of Administrative Hearings issued notice of a hearing scheduled for November 25, 2013, at 9:30 a.m. On November 26, 2013 Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Kirkwood issued Hearing Decision 13-UI-5302, dismissing claimant's request for a hearing for failure to appear. On December 18, 2013, claimant filed a timely request to reopen the hearing. ALJ Kangas reviewed claimant's request to reopen and on January 3, 2014, issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-07661, denying claimant's request. On January 17, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Claimant failed to certify that he provided a copy of his argument to the other parties as required by OAR 471-041-0080(2)(a) (October 29, 2006). Therefore, we did not consider the argument when reaching this decision.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 677.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted.**

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-07661 is affirmed.
