

**EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION**

**2014-EAB-0193**

*Affirmed*  
*Disqualification*

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On November 8, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant voluntarily left work without good cause (decision # 132201). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On January 7, 2014, ALJ Vincent conducted a hearing, and on January 29, 2014 issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-09383, affirming the Department's decision. On January 31, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

In her written argument, claimant asserted that the ALJ was biased. We reviewed the hearing record in its entirety, which shows that the ALJ inquired fully into the matters at issue and gave all parties reasonable opportunity for a fair hearing as required by ORS 657.270(3) and OAR 471-040-0025(1) (August 1, 2004). We considered claimant's remaining arguments when reaching this decision.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decision 14-UI-09383 is affirmed.
