## **EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION**

2014-EAB-0198

Affirmed Overpayment and Penalties

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On August 13, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served a three part administrative decision: part one assessing a \$4,678 overpayment and \$701.70 in monetary penalties based on unreported work and earnings; part two assessing a \$5,612 overpayment and \$841.80 in monetary penalties based on unreported work and earnings; and part three assessing a \$2,713 overpayment, \$406.95 in monetary penalties and 52 penalty weeks based on unreported work and earnings (decision # 194112). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On December 10, 2013, and continued to January 2, 2014, ALJ Vincent conducted an interpreted consolidated hearing, and on January 21, 2014, issued Hearing Decisions 14-UI-08804, 14-UI-08805 and 14-UI-08806, affirming the Department's decisions. On February 3, 2014, claimant filed applications for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Pursuant to OAR 471-041-0095 (October 29, 2006), EAB consolidated its review of Hearing Decisions 14-UI-08804, 14-UI-08805 and 14-UI-08806. For case-tracking purposes, this decision is being issued in triplicate (EAB Decisions 2014-EAB-0197, 2014-EAB-0198 and 2014-EAB-0199).

EAB considered claimant's written argument to the extent it was based on the hearing record.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decisions under review are **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decisions 14-UI-08804, 14-UI-08805 and 14-UI-08806 are affirmed.
