PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On July 3, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant failed to properly register for work. On July 23, 2013, the July 3, 2013 administrative decision became final without a request for hearing having been filed. On December 5, 2013, claimant filed a request for hearing. On December 27, 2013, ALJ Kangas issued Hearing Decision 13-UI-07172, dismissing claimant's request for hearing as untimely, subject to claimant's "right to renew" the request by submitting a response to the "Appellant Questionnaire" attached to the hearing decision within 14 days of the date the decision was mailed. On January 6, 2014, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) received claimant's response. ALJ Kangas reviewed claimant's response and on February 5, 2014, issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-09854, re-dismissing claimant's request for hearing. On February 12, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-09854 is affirmed.
