

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION

2014-EAB-0268

*Affirmed
Disqualification*

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On November 4, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant voluntarily left work without good cause (decision # 130702). Decision # 130702 became final on September 25, 2013 without a request for hearing having been filed. On December 4, 2013, claimant filed a request for hearing. On December 27, 2013, 2013, ALJ Kangas issued Hearing Decision 13-UI-07161, dismissing claimant's request for hearing as untimely, subject to claimant's "right to renew" the request by submitting a response to the "Appellant Questionnaire" attached to the hearing decision within 14 days of the date the decision was mailed.¹ On December 30, 2013, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) received claimant's response. On February 11, 2013, ALJ Kirkwood conducted a hearing, and issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-10126, allowing claimant's late request for hearing, and concluding that claimant voluntarily left work without good cause. On February 18, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-10126 is affirmed.
