

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION

2014-EAB-0281

Affirmed
Ineligible

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On October 31, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served two notices of two administrative decisions concluding claimant was not available for work (decisions # 154412 and # 145458), and one notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant did not actively seek work (decision #150146). Claimant filed a request for hearing. On January 15, 2014, ALJ Monroe conducted a consolidated hearing, and on February 13, 2014, issued Hearing Decisions 14-UI-10306, 14-UI-10307 and 14-UI-10308 affirming the Department's decisions. On February 19, 2014, claimant filed three applications for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Pursuant to OAR 471-041-0095 (October 29, 2006), EAB consolidated its review of Hearing Decisions 14-UI-10306, 14-UI-10307 and 14-UI-10308¹. For case-tracking purposes, this decision is being issued in triplicate (EAB Decisions 2014-EAB-0281, 2014-EAB-0282 and 2014-EAB-0283).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decisions under review are **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decisions 14-UI-10306, 14-UI-10307 and 14-UI-10308 are affirmed.

¹ In Hearing Decision 14-UI-10308, ALJ Monroe's Order incorrectly identified claimant's dates of ineligibility. The last sentence in the Order (page 4) should read: "Claimant is not eligible to receive benefits for the period October 13, 2013 through January 11, **2014**."
