

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION

2014-EAB-0317

Affirmed
Ineligible

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On November 29, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant was not available for work from November 3, 2013 through November 23, 2013 (decision # 103015). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On January 30, 2014, ALJ Clink conducted a hearing, and on February 7, 2014 issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-10017, affirming the Department's decision. ALJ Clink took jurisdiction over additional weeks from November 24, 2013 through December 14, 2013 because the Department denied benefits for those weeks for the same reason. The weeks at issue are November 3, 2013 through December 14, 2014. On February 24, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-10017 is affirmed.
