EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION
2014-EAB-0335

Affirmed
No Disqualification

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On December 24, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served two notices of two administrative decisions, one concluding claimant was available for work from December 1, 2013 through December 7, 2013 (decision # 95528), and another concluding the employer discharged claimant but not for misconduct (decision # 93554). On January 2, 2014, the employer filed a request for hearing. On February 4, 2014, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) issued two notices of a consolidated hearing scheduled for February 18, 2014. On February 18, 2014, ALJ Wipperman conducted a consolidated hearing, and on February 25, 2014, issued Hearing Decisions 14-UI-11094 and 14-UI-11095, affirming the Department's decisions. On February 27, 2014, the employer filed applications for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Pursuant to OAR 471-041-0095 (October 29, 2006), EAB consolidated its review of Hearing Decisions 14-UI-11094 and 14-UI-11095. For case-tracking purposes, this decision is being issued in duplicate (EAB Decisions 2014-EAB-0334 and 2014-EAB-0335).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decisions under review are **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decisions 14-UI-11094 and 14-UI-11095 are affirmed.
