## EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2014-EAB-0351

## Affirmed No Disqualification

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On November 8, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that the employer discharged claimant for misconduct (decision # 80718). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On January 21, 2014, ALJ Monroe conducted a hearing at which the employer did not appear, and on February 18, 2014, issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-10587, concluding that the employer discharged claimant but not for misconduct. On February 27, 2014, the employer filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

The employer's argument contained information that was not part of the hearing record, and failed to show that factors or circumstances beyond the employer's reasonable control prevented the employer from offering the information during the hearing. Under ORS 657.275(2) and OAR 471-041-0090 (October 29, 2006), we considered only information received into evidence at the hearing when reaching this decision.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decision 14-UI-10587 is affirmed.
