

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION

2014-EAB-0360

Reversed & Remanded

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On December 27, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that the employer discharged claimant but not for misconduct (decision # 104101). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On February 24, 2014, ALJ Micheletti conducted a hearing, and on February 26, 2014, issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-11149, concluding that the employer discharged claimant but not for misconduct. On March 4, 2014, the employer filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

ORS 657.275 provides that EAB shall review the record of the case and promptly affirm, modify, or set aside the decision of the ALJ if the Director of the Department or any interested party files a timely application for review. On March 4, 2014, EAB notified OAH that an application for review had been filed. The record is not yet complete,¹ however, and it appears that further proceedings are or may be necessary before the record can be provided. We therefore reverse Hearing Decision 14-UI-11149 as unsupported by a complete record, and remand for such other and further proceedings as may be necessary.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-11149 is set aside, and this matter remanded for further proceedings consistent with this order.
