Late Request for Hearing Dismissed

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On August 26, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant voluntarily left work without good cause (decision # 113710). On September 16, 2013, decision # 113710 became final without a request for hearing having been filed. On September 18, 2013, claimant filed a request for hearing. On October 10, 2013, ALJ Kangas issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-02286, dismissing claimant's request for hearing as untimely, subject to claimant's "right to renew" the request by submitting a response to the "Appellant Questionnaire" attached to the hearing decision within 14 days of the date the decision was mailed. On October 23, 2013, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) received claimant's response. On October 31, 2013, OAH issued a letter in which it cancelled the order (Hearing Decision 14-UI-02286) dismissing claimant's hearing request. On February 13, 2014, OAH issued notice of a hearing scheduled for March 3, 2014 at 9:30 a.m. On March 3, 2014, ALJ Sime conducted a hearing at which claimant appeared and testified, and on March 6, 2014, issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-11827, dismissing claimant's late request for hearing. On March 11, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-11827 is affirmed.
