## **EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION**

2014-EAB-0398

Affirmed Disqualification

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On December 4, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that the employer discharged claimant but not for misconduct (decision # 153539). The employer filed a timely request for hearing. On February 13, 2014, ALJ Vincent conducted a hearing at which the claimant did not appear, and on March 7, 2014, issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-12008, concluding the claimant voluntarily left work without good cause. On March 13, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Claimant's argument contained information that was not part of the hearing record. Claimant failed to show that circumstances beyond claimant's reasonable control prevented claimant from offering the information during the hearing. Under ORS 657.275(2) and OAR 471-041-0090 (October 29, 2006), we considered only information received into evidence at the hearing when reaching this decision.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decision 14-UI-12008 is affirmed.
