

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION
2014-EAB-0401

Affirmed
Backdating Request Denied

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On February 11, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision denying claimant's request to backdate her initial claim to the week ending December 28, 2013 (decision #1550559). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On March 13, 2014, ALJ Shoemake conducted a hearing, and on March 14, 2014, issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-12503, affirming the Department's decision. On March 17, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-12503 is affirmed.
