EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2014-EAB-0422

Affirmed No Disqualification

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On December 2, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant voluntarily left work with good cause (decision # 140902). On December 23, 2013, decision # 140902 became final without a request for hearing having been filed. On December 27, 2013, the employer filed an untimely request for hearing. On January 17, 2014, ALJ Kangas issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-08744, dismissing the employer's request for hearing as untimely, subject to the employer's "right to renew" the request by submitting a response to the "Appelant Questionnaire" attached to the hearing decision within 14 days of the date the decision was mailed.¹ On January 31, 2014, The Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) received the employer's response. On February 26, 2014 ALJ Kangas reviewed the employer's response and issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-11163, dismissing the employer's request for hearing. On March 18, 2014, the employer filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-11163 is affirmed.
