EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2014-EAB-0445

Application for Review Dismissed

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On January 23, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding the employer discharged claimant for misconduct (decision # 73152). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On February 27, 2014, ALJ Wyatt conducted a hearing, and on February 28, 2014 issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-11450, affirming the Department's decision. On March 20, 2014, Hearing Decision 14-UI-11450 became final without an application for review having been filed. On March 25, 2014, claimant filed by facsimile a late application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Claimant failed to certify she provided a copy of her argument to the other parties as required by OAR 471-041-0080(2)(a) (October 29, 2006). Therefore, we did not consider the argument when reaching this decision.

CONCLUSIONS AND REASONS: Claimant did not establish good cause to file an untimely application for review, and her application for review should be dismissed.

ORS 657.270(4) required the claimant's application for review to be filed no later than March 20, 2014; it was filed on March 25, 2014, as shown by the fax transmission date and the receipt date stamped on the application for review. OAR 471-041-0065(1)(c) (October 29, 2006) (if faxed, the filing date is the receipt date stamped or written on the fax transmission by the public employee who receives the document.). OAR 471-041-0070(3) requires that individuals filing late applications for review include with the late application "a written statement describing the circumstances that prevented a timely filing." Claimant did not provide any explanation as to why she filed her application 5 days after the filing deadline expired.

Because the application for review was filed after the 20-day deadline provided by ORS 657.270(4), and good cause to extend the time allowed has not been shown, the application for review must be dismissed.

DECISION: The application for review filed March 25, 2014 is dismissed. Hearing Decision 14-UI-11450 remains undisturbed.
