

## EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION

2014-EAB-0446

### *Application for Review Dismissed*

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On December 20, 2013, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant was not available for work from November 3, 2013 to December 14, 2013 (decision # 153812). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On February 13, 2014, ALJ Erwin conducted a hearing, and on February 18, 2014, issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-10544, affirming the Department's decision. On March 10, 2014, Hearing Decision 14-UI-10544 became final without an application for review having been filed. On March 20, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

**CONCLUSIONS AND REASONS:** Claimant did not establish good cause to file an untimely application for review, and her application for review should be dismissed.

ORS 657.270(4) required claimant's application for review to be filed no later than March 10, 2014; it was filed on March 20, 2014, as shown by the stamped postmark date on the envelope in which it was mailed. OAR 471-041-0065 (October 29, 2006). OAR 471-041-0070(3) requires that individuals filing late applications for review include with the late application "a written statement describing the circumstances that prevented a timely filing." Claimant did not provide any explanation as to why she filed her application 10 days after the filing deadline expired.

Because the application for review was filed after the 20-day deadline provided by ORS 657.270(4), and good cause to extend the time allowed has not been shown, the application for review must be dismissed.

**DECISION:** The application for review filed March 20, 2014 is dismissed. Hearing Decision 14-UI-10544 remains undisturbed.
