## EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION

## 2014-EAB-0499

## Affirmed <br> No Disqualification

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On March 4, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant voluntarily left work without good cause (decision \# 90016). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On March 25, 2014, ALJ Vaughn conducted a hearing, and on March 26, 2014, issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-13487, concluding claimant voluntarily left work with good cause. On March 31, 2014, the employer filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

The employer failed to certify that it provided a copy of its argument to the other parties as required by OAR 471-041-0080(2)(a) (October 29, 2006). Therefore, we did not consider the argument when reaching this decision.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On de novo review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is adopted.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-13487 is affirmed.
