

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION

2014-EAB-0505

Affirmed
Disqualification

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On January 10, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant voluntarily left work without good cause (decision # 82056). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On March 11, 2014, ALJ M. Davis conducted a hearing, and on March 12, 2014, issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-12188, affirming the Department's decision. On April 1, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

In claimant's written argument, claimant included information that was not part of the hearing record. Claimant failed to certify that a copy of the written argument was provided to the other parties as required. Under ORS 657.275 (2), OAR 471-041-0080 (October 29, 2006), and OAR 471-041-0090 (October 29, 2006), we did not consider claimant's written argument when reaching this decision.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-12188 is affirmed.
