

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION

2014-EAB-0510

Affirmed
Ineligible

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On January 3, 2014 and amended on January 6, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant was ineligible for benefits from December 15, 2013 to December 21, 2013 because he failed to attend a Reemployment and Eligibility Assessment (REA) appointment (decision # 95845). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On March 7, 2014, ALJ Shoemake conducted a hearing, and on March 12, 2014, issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-12227, affirming the Department's decision. On March 31, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB considered claimant's written argument to the extent it was relevant and based on the hearing record.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-12227 is affirmed.
