Affirmed No Disqualification

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On January 16, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding the employer discharged claimant for misconduct (decision # 150829). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On April 1, 2014, ALJ Messecar conducted a hearing, and on April 16, 2014, issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-15345, concluding the employer discharged claimant but not for misconduct. On April 18, 2014, the employer filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

In the employer's written argument, the employer included information that was not part of the hearing record. Under OAR 471-041-0090 (October 29, 2006), EAB may consider information not included in the hearing record if the party offering the information shows that circumstances beyond the party's reasonable control prevented the party from presenting the information at hearing. The employer provided no explanation as to why the information in his written argument was not presented at hearing. In addition, the employer failed to certify that a copy of the written argument was provided to the other parties as required by OAR 471-041-0080(2)(a). Accordingly, we did not consider the employer's written argument in reaching this decision.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-15345 is affirmed.
