

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION
2014-EAB-0644

Affirmed
Ineligible (weeks 9-12 through 12-14 and week 14-14)

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On March 12, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant was not available for work from February 23, 2014 to March 1, 2014 (decision # 112222). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On April 7, 2014, ALJ R. Frank conducted a hearing, and on April 11, 2014, issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-15021, concluding claimant was not available for work from February 23, 2014 to March 22, 2014 (weeks 9-14 through 12-14), and March 30, 2014 to April 5, 2014 (week 14-14), but was eligible for benefits from March 23, 2014 to March 29, 2014 (week 13-14). On April 17, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-15021 is affirmed.
