

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION

2014-EAB-0733

*Affirmed
Disqualification*

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On February 19, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant voluntarily left work with good cause (decision # 142725). The employer filed a timely request for hearing. On April 18, 2014, ALJ Wipperman conducted a hearing, and on April 23, 2014, issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-15874, concluding claimant voluntarily left work without good cause. On April 30, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-15874 is affirmed.
