PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On March 26, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant filed late claims for benefits (decision # 81901). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On April 21, 2014, ALJ Clink conducted a hearing, and on April 28, 2014 issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-16228, affirming the Department's decision. On May 5, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

OAR 471-040-0023 (August 1, 2004) requires the Department to make an audio or stenographic record of any telephone hearing. We have examined the record in this matter and find that the audio recording of the April 21, 2014 hearing begins after the Department's witness testified. On information and belief, no recording of that witness's testimony exists. Because there is no audio or stenographic record of the full hearing conducted on April 21, 2014, the record before us is insufficient to support the findings contained in the hearing decision. The decision is therefore reversed, and the matter remanded for a new hearing and new decision.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-16228 is set aside, and this matter remanded for further proceedings consistent with this order.
