## **EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION**

2014-EAB-0866

Affirmed
No Disqualification

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On March 25, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding the employer discharged claimant, not for misconduct (decision # 124315). The employer filed a timely request for hearing. On May 7, 2014, ALJ Clink conducted a hearing, and on May 9, 2014 issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-17336, affirming the Department's decision. On May 16, 2014, the employer filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

At hearing, claimant and the employer's witness, his supervisor, disagreed on the events leading to claimant's work separation. In Hearing Decision 14-UI-17336, the ALJ found facts in accordance with claimant's testimony and, based on those facts, concluded that claimant was discharged, not for misconduct.<sup>1</sup> EAB reviewed the entire hearing record, and found no basis for disagreeing with the ALJ's implicit credibility finding in favor of claimant or, therefore, the ALJ's findings of fact, and conclusion that the employer discharged claimant, not for misconduct. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), Hearing Decision 14-UI-17336 is **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decision 14-UI-17336 is affirmed.
