

## EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION

2014-EAB-0939

*Affirmed*  
*No Disqualification*  
*(No Descalificación)*

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On January 14, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant voluntarily left work without good cause (decision # 75643). On April 21, 2014, claimant filed a late request for hearing. On May 14, 2014, ALJ Holmes-Swanson conducted a hearing in which the employer did not participate, and on May 21, 2014 issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-18054, concluding the employer discharged claimant but not for misconduct. On June 2, 2014, the employer filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decision 14-UI-18054 is affirmed.
