## EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2014-EAB-0969

Affirmed Ineligible Weeks 02-14, 03-14 and 09-14

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On April 21, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that claimant did not actively seek work from January 5 through 18, 2014 (weeks 02-14 and 03-14) and January 26 through February 2, 2014 (week 09-14) (decision # 101328). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On May 23, 2014, ALJ Shoemake conducted a hearing, and on May 28, 2014, issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-18500, affirming the administrative decision. On June 5, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB considered claimant's written argument to the extent it was relevant and based on the hearing record.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted.** 

**DECISION:** Hearing Decision 14-UI-18500 is affirmed.
