EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2014-EAB-1138

Affirmed Request to Reopen Denied

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On April 23, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding the employer discharged claimant for misconduct (decision # 140036). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On May 5, 2014, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) issued notice of a hearing scheduled for May 19, 2014 at 9:30 a.m. On May 19, 2014, ALJ M. Davis issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-17885, dismissing claimant's request for hearing for failure to appear. Claimant filed a timely request to reopen the hearing. On June 25, 2014, ALJ M. Davis conducted a hearing at which claimant appeared and testified, and on June 26, 2014, issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-20466, denying claimant's request.

EAB considered claimant's written argument to the extent it was relevant and based on the hearing record. Claimant disagreed with the ALJ that he did not reside in his home on the date of the original hearing. Claimant stated: "I was unable to call in for my May 19th court date due to my wife not letting me into the house the night before...my only concern was finding a place to sleep for the night." Claimant made no attempt to contact OAH to make arrangements to participate in the hearing or to request a postponement. Claimant failed to show that it was outside his reasonable control to appear at the hearing or contact OAH, thus he did not show he had good cause for failing to appear at the original hearing.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-20466 is affirmed.
