Late Request for Hearing Denied

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On January 8, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant voluntarily left work without good cause (decision # 75653). On January 28, 2014, decision # 75653 became final without a request for hearing having been filed. On May 8, 2014, claimant filed a late request for hearing.

On May 15, 2014, ALJ Kangas issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-17647, dismissing claimant's request for hearing as untimely, subject to claimant's "right to renew" the request by submitting responses to the "Appellant Questionnaire" attached to the hearing decision within 14 days of the date the decision was mailed. On May 22, 2014, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) received claimant's response. On June 16, 2014, OAH issued a letter entitled "Cancellation of Hearing Decision." On June 30, 2014, ALJ Frank conducted a hearing in which claimant appeared and testified, and on July 3, 2014 issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-20869, re-dismissing claimant's request for hearing. On July 18, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decisions under review are **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-20869 is affirmed. Administrative decision # 75653 remains undisturbed.
