Affirmed Overpayment, No Penalties

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On June 24, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision (decision #142454) concluding claimant was not able to work from January 19, 2014 to March 8, 2014 (weeks 4-14 through 10-14). On July 14, 2014, decision # 142454 became final without a request for hearing having been filed. On June 25, 2014, the Department served notice of an administrative decision (decision # 195120) assessing a \$3,766 overpayment, a \$1,129.80 in monetary penalties, and 28 penalty weeks based on decision # 142454. Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On August 1, 2014, ALJ Lohr conducted a hearing and issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-22695, modifying the Department's decision and assessing a \$3,766 overpayment with no monetary penalties or penalty weeks. On August 19, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-22695 is affirmed.
