Reversed & Remanded

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On June 23, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that the employer discharged claimant for misconduct (decision # 152005). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On July 24, July 30 and August 25, 2014, ALJ Vincent conducted a hearing, and on September 3, 2014, issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-24462, concluding that the employer discharged claimant, but not for misconduct. On September 15, 2014, the employer filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

CONCLUSIONS AND REASONS: Hearing Decision 14-UI-24462 is reversed for lack of a complete record, and this matter remanded to OAH for further proceedings consistent with this order.

ORS 657.275 provides that EAB shall review the record of a case and promptly affirm, modify, or set aside the decision of the ALJ if the Director of the Department or any interested party files a timely application for review. The record we received in this case is incomplete. Although the ALJ admitted exhibits 1-3 into evidence, the record contains no marked copies of these exhibits.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-24462 is set aside, and this matter remanded for further proceedings consistent with this order.
