EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2014-EAB-1825

Affirmed Request to Reopen Denied

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On July 2, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision (# 15027) finding that claimant was not eligible for benefits under the Supplemental Unemployment Insurance for Dislocated Workers (SUD) program. On August 5, 2014, decision # 15027 became final without a request for hearing having been filed. On August 20, 2014, the Department served notice of an administrative decision (# 10258) assessing a \$1,048 overpayment for the period June 15, 2014 through June 28, 2014 (weeks 25-14 and 26-14) based on decision # 15027. Claimant filed a timely request for hearing on decision # 15027. On September 17, 2014, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) issued notice of a hearing scheduled for October 6, 2014 at 10:45 a.m. Claimant did not appear at the hearing. On October 6, 2014, ALJ R. Davis issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-26425, dismissing claimant's request for hearing for failure to appear. On October 27, 2014, claimant filed a timely request to reopen the hearing. On November 6, 2014, ALJ Kangas reviewed claimant's request to reopen and issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-28276, denying claimant's request. On November 26, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-28276 is affirmed. Hearing Decision 14-UI-26425 remains undisturbed.
