

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION

2014-EAB-1834

*Affirmed
Disqualification*

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On October 15, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of two administrative decisions. Decision # 104621 concluded claimant was not available for work for the week of September 21 through September 27, 2014 (week 39-14). Decision # 103236 concluded the employer discharged claimant for misconduct. Claimant filed timely requests for hearing. On November 12, 2014, ALJ M. Davis conducted two hearings, and on November 14, 2014 issued Hearing Decisions 14-UI-28690 and 14-UI-28691, affirming the administrative decisions. On November 25, 2014, claimant filed applications for review of both hearing decisions with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Claimant failed to certify that he provided a copy of his written argument to the other parties as required by OAR 471-041-0080(2)(a) (October 29, 2006). Therefore, we did not consider the argument when reaching this decision.

Pursuant to OAR 471-041-0095 (October 29, 2006), EAB consolidated its review of Hearing Decisions 14-UI-28690 and 14-UI-28691. For case-tracking purposes, this decision is being issued in duplicate (EAB Decisions 2014-EAB-1834 and 2014-EAB-1835).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decisions under review are **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decisions 14-UI-28690 and 14-UI-28691 are affirmed.
