PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On October 29, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notices of two administrative decisions. Decision # 151339 concluded claimant voluntarily left work without good cause; decision # 200566 assessed a \$13,825 overpayment, \$2,073.75 in monetary penalties, and 52 penalty weeks based on decision # 151339. Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On November 25, 2014, ALJ R. Frank conducted a consolidated hearing, and on November 28, 2014 issued Hearing Decisions 14-UI-29527 and 14-UI-29531, affirming the Department's decisions. On December 9, 2014, claimant filed applications for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Pursuant to OAR 471-041-0095 (October 29, 2006), EAB consolidated its review of Hearing Decisions 14-UI-29527 and 14-UI-29531. For case-tracking purposes, this decision is being issued in duplicate (EAB Decisions 2014-EAB-1875 and 2014-EAB-1876).

Claimant failed to certify that she provided a copy of her argument to the other parties as required by OAR 471-041-0080(2)(a) (October 29, 2006). Therefore, we did not consider the argument when reaching this decision.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing records. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decisions under review are **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decisions 14-UI-29527 and 14-UI-29531 are affirmed.
