Affirmed Disqualification

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On September 5, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision (decision # 84814) concluding claimant did not actively seek work during the week of July 13 to July 19, 2014 (week 29-14). On September 25, 2014, decision # 84814 became final without a request for hearing having been filed. On October 8, 2014, claimant filed an untimely request for hearing. On October 28, 2014, ALJ Kangas issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-27652, dismissing claimant's request for hearing as untimely, subject to claimant's "right to renew" the request by submitting a response to the "Appellant Questionnaire" attached to the hearing decision within 14 days of the date the decision was mailed. On November 5, 2014, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) received claimant's response. On November 21, 2014, the OAH issued a "Cancellation of Hearing Decision" for Hearing Decision 14-UI-27652. On December 16, 2014, ALJ Murdock conducted a hearing, and on December 19, 2014 issued Hearing Decision 14-UI-30672, dismissing claimant's request for hearing. On December 30, 2014, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 14-UI-30672 is affirmed.
