

**EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION**  
**2015-EAB-0198**

*Affirmed*  
*Disqualification*

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On December 30, 2014, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding the employer discharged claimant for misconduct (decision # 91909). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On February 9, 2015, ALJ Vincent conducted a hearing,<sup>1</sup> and on February 11, 2015 issued Hearing Decision 15-UI-33361, affirming the Department's decision. On February 23, 2015, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decision 15-UI-33361 is affirmed.
