

**EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION**  
**2015-EAB-0537**

*Affirmed*  
*No Disqualification*

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On March 13, 2015, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant voluntarily left work with good cause (decision # 144140). The employer filed a timely request for hearing. On April 8, 2015, ALJ Wipperman conducted a hearing, and on April 15, 2015 issued Hearing Decision 15-UI-36937, affirming the Department's decision. On May 4, 2015, the employer filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

The EAB considered the employer's written argument to the extent it was relevant and based on the hearing record.<sup>1</sup>

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decision 15-UI-36937 is affirmed.
