

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION
2015-EAB-0574

Affirmed
Late Request for Hearing Dismissed
Overpayment and Penalties

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On April 28, 2011, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding claimant willfully made a misrepresentation to obtain benefits, and assessing a \$3,031 overpayment, \$454.65 in monetary penalties and 26 penalty weeks. On May 18, 2011, the overpayment decision became final without a request for hearing having been filed. On April 15, 2015, claimant filed a late request for hearing. On April 23, 2015, ALJ Kangas issued Hearing Decision 15-UI-37364, dismissing claimant's request for hearing as untimely, subject to claimant's "right to renew" the request by submitting responses to the "Appellant Questionnaire" attached to the hearing decision within 14 days of the date the decision was mailed.¹ On April 29, 2015, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) received claimant's response. On May 12, 2015, ALJ Kangas reviewed claimant's response and issued Hearing Decision 15-UI-38301, cancelling Hearing Decision 15-UI-37364, and re-dismissing claimant's April 15, 2015 request for hearing. On May 15, 2015, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 15-UI-38301 is affirmed.
