

**EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION**  
**2015-EAB-0730**

*Affirmed*  
*Late Request for Hearing Dismissed*  
*Overpayment Assessed*

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On March 20, 2015, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision (decision #90452) concluding that claimant did not actively seek work from January 11 through February 28, 2015 (weeks 02-15 through 08-15). On April 9, 2015, decision #90452 became final without a request for hearing having been filed.

On April 22, 2015, the Department served notice of an administrative decision (decision #115903) concluding that claimant was overpaid \$1,729 in unemployment benefits, based on decision #90452. On April 28, 2015, claimant filed a late request for hearing on decision #90452 and a timely request for hearing on decision #115903. On May 22, 2015, ALJ Murdock conducted two hearings and on May 27, 2015, issued the following hearing decisions: Hearing Decision 15-UI-39093, dismissing claimant's late request for a hearing on decision #90452 and Hearing Decision 15-UI-39095, affirming the overpayment decision (decision #115903). On June 15, 2015, claimant filed applications for review of both hearing decisions with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Pursuant to OAR 471-041-0095 (October 29, 2006), EAB consolidated its review of Hearing Decisions 15-UI-39093 and 15-UI-39095. For case-tracking purposes, this decision is being issued in duplicate (EAB Decisions 2015-EAB-0729 and 2015-EAB-730).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing records. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decisions under review are **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decisions 15-UI-39093 and 15-UI-39095 are affirmed.
