Affirmed No Disqualification

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On April 8, 2015, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that claimant willfully made a false statement or misrepresentation to obtain benefits and disqualifying claimant from four weeks of future benefits (decision #201676). Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On May 26, 2015, ALJ Vincent conducted a hearing, and on June 26, 2015, issued Hearing Decision 15-UI-49785, reversing the administrative decision and concluding that claimant was not disqualified from future benefits. On July 13, 2015, the employer filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 15-UI-40785 is affirmed.
