EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2015-EAB-0858

Affirmed Ineligible

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On May 29, 2015, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that claimant did not file her claim for week 18-15 (May 3 through 9, 2015) in accordance with the regulations prescribed by the Department Director. Claimant filed a timely request for hearing. On June 23, 2015 ALJ Vincent conducted a hearing, and on July 9, 2015, ALJ Holmes-Swanson issued Hearing Decision 15-UI-41251, concluding that the claimant failed to file her claims for weeks 18-15 through 20-15 (May 3 through 23, 2015) in accordance with the regulations prescribed by the Department Director. On July 14, 2015, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Claimant failed to certify that she provided a copy of her argument to the other parties as required by OAR 471-041-0080(2)(a) (October 29, 2006). Therefore, we did not consider the argument when reaching this decision.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 15-UI-41251 is affirmed.
