

EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION
2015-EAB-0877

Affirmed
Ineligible

PROCEDURAL HISTORY: On May 19, 2015, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of two administrative decisions: decision #65038 concluded that claimant failed to file her claim for week 15-15 (April 12 through April 18, 2015) in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Department Director; and decision #65220 concluded that claimant failed to file her claim for week 17-15 (April 26 through May 2, 2015) in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Department Director. Claimant filed timely requests for hearing. On June 24, 2015, ALJ Holmes-Swanson conducted a hearing, and on July 1, 2015, issued Hearing Decision 15-UI-40949, which affirmed decision #65038, and Hearing Decision 15-UI-40956, which affirmed decision #65220. On July 21, 2015, claimant filed applications for review of both hearing decisions with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Pursuant to OAR 471-041-0095 (October 29, 2006), EAB consolidated its review of Hearing Decisions 15-UI-40949 and 15-UI-40956. For case-tracking purposes, this decision is being issued in duplicate (EAB Decisions 2015-EAB-0877 and 2015-EAB-0878).

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decisions under review are **adopted**.

DECISION: Hearing Decision 15-UI-40959 and 15-UI-40956 are affirmed.
