## EMPLOYMENT APPEALS BOARD DECISION 2015-EAB-0900

Affirmed
Request to Reopen Denied

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY:** On April 24, 2015, the Oregon Employment Department (the Department) served notice of an administrative decision concluding that the employer discharged claimant, but not for misconduct (decision # 100737). The employer filed a timely request for hearing. On June 26, 2015, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) issued notice of a hearing scheduled for June 8, 2015. On June 8, 2015, ALJ Logan conducted a hearing in which claimant did not participate, and on June 10, 2015, issued Hearing Decision 15-UI-39832, concluding that claimant voluntarily left work without good cause. On June 19, 2015, claimant filed a request to reopen the hearing with OAH. On July 10, 2015, ALJ R. Davis conducted an interpreted hearing and on July 16, 2015, issued Hearing Decision 15-UI-41550, denying claimant's request to reopen. On July 27, 2015, claimant filed an application for review with the Employment Appeals Board (EAB).

Claimant failed to certify that she provided a copy of her argument to the other parties as required by OAR 471-041-0080(2)(a) (October 29, 2006). Therefore, we did not consider the argument when reaching this decision.

EAB reviewed the entire hearing record. On *de novo* review and pursuant to ORS 657.275(2), the hearing decision under review is **adopted**.

**DECISION:** Hearing Decision 15-UI-41550 is affirmed.
